

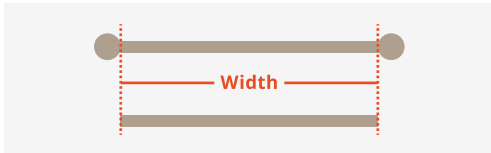

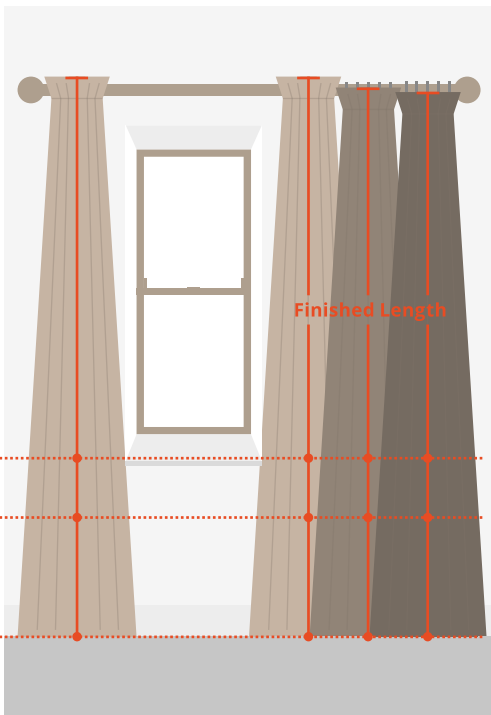

## How to measure for Curtains



### Step 1 Measuring the width

1. If you have a pole, measure the full width excluding the end finials.
2. If you have a track, measure the full width of the track.



### Step 2 Measuring the length

1. Choose where you would like your curtains to fall to. This may be to the sill, below the sill or floor level.
2. Measure your length at each end, and at the centre of your track/pole. Where the values vary, choose the most suitable. This is usually the smallest value.

#### Where to measure from:

**Eyelet Heading** – Measure from the top of the pole. There needs to be at least 5cm clearance above the pole.

**Pencil Pleat Tape (Poles)** – Measure from the bottom of the eyelets on the rings. This is the hook drop.

**Pencil Pleat Tape (Tracks)** – For curtains covered by a pelmet/valance measure the hook drop. Please make a note of this in the comments. If the curtains need to conceal the track, measure from the top of the track. This is the *finished* drop.

**Hand pleated (eg pinch pleat)** – Choose how much of the pole you want to show (see diagram) Measure from this point. This is the *finished* drop.
